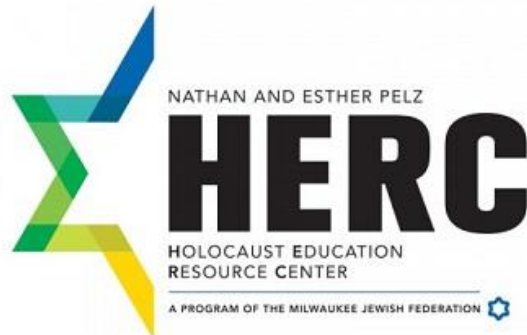


Helena and Siegfried Richheimer Summer Internship Program



The Nathan and Esther Pelz Holocaust Education Resource Center (HERC) is the only organization in Wisconsin solely devoted to Holocaust education. We work throughout the state training educators, students, and the community about Holocaust history. We believe that it is only through learning about the dangerous and destructive course taken by the Nazis- of hatred, bigotry, and racism- that we can inspire our future generations to sustain a peaceful and just society for all.

HERC is seeking a summer intern to join our small, tight-knit team. The intern will assist the Education Department with researching and editing for their digital training tool, the Holocaust Education Map, as well as assist in the collection of data from educational initiatives. Be part of something bigger and join a team of dedicated professionals.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Researching sources for the Holocaust Education Map
- Drafting and/or editing lesson plans for the Holocaust Education Map
- Sending out feedback surveys
- Organizing survey information
- Conduct interviews with educators

Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate school program; history, education, or genocide studies preferred
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Proficient with Survey Monkey survey software preferred
- Knowledge of Holocaust history and/or data analytics and audience evaluation a plus
- Ability to multi-task and meet deadlines
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team

Internship Schedule:

Internship start date is flexible, ideally beginning end of May/early June and ending by mid-August. Weekly availability Tuesday through Thursday, 9am-4pm. Intern is not to exceed 20 hours per week. In-person training required during first few weeks, after which a hybrid option available.

Internship includes a stipend and is eligible for college credits as set for by the candidate's degree program.
